March 8, 2018	<b>“Intent to Graduate” applications due; LAST DAY TO RSVP FOR CEREMONY ATTENDANCE.</b> \$20 fee per degree (If applying for an AS with imbedded College Credit Certificates (CCC), pay only \$20 fee for the AS degree; you will also receive the CCCs. If applying for a CCC only, there is a \$20 fee per application.)					
Effective March 9, \$20 late fee assessed for “Intent to Graduate” applications. Students may still apply for graduation after the published deadline and the EFSC Office of the Registrar will make every effort to process documents as quickly as possible. However, students will be assessed a late fee and the Office of the Registrar cannot guarantee that students who submit applications after the deadline will have their name in the Commencement Booklet or be notified of outstanding graduation requirements in a timely manner. Students who plan to attend the commencement ceremony must RSVP by March 8.
