

## What is VPI?

1. Vocational Preparatory Instruction (VPI) is a group of learning specialists who focus on helping the vocational students meet their graduation goal through successful completion of the TABE or TEAS.
2. VPI provides one-on-one tutoring in math, language and reading .
3. Specialists have resources for preparing for the TABE and TEAS tests including on-line software and workbooks.
4. VPI specialists work with you to determine when to retest on the TABE.
5. VPI can help you determine your preferred learning style, improve your study skills and note taking skills, and enjoy learning more.

**Take your TABE as soon as possible. It is better to get your TABE test behind you so if you need remediation (tutoring) we can get started!**
