III. Suggestions for changes.

- Use indicators as defined rather than rubrics to guide/define assessment
- Collect at the classroom level, but discuss core abilities throughout the program
 - Expand discussion (Closing the Loop) to Core Abilities, cohorts of students
- Allow for individual selection of core abilities rather than discipline-chosen coverage
 - Historically this has offered coverage of all core abilities
- Offering marketing of the Core Abilities to ensure all faculty and staff understand their importance and presence in every student activity/class
- Expand courses assessing
 - All courses assess?
 - Expanded list of courses assess?
