Thank you for your interest in becoming a peer tutor for the Academic Success Center (ASC).

Financial Aid Work-Study peer tutors are permitted to work up to 20 hours per week.

The minimum requirements for this position are:

- An A in the course is preferred, but a B will be considered based on individual circumstances and other aspects of the application.
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Good academic standing
- High school diploma or equivalent
- At least 18 years of age
- Currently enrolled in at least 6 credits (Fall, Spring)

If you would like to apply for this position, please complete the following steps:

1. Fill out the ASC Peer Tutor Application Form.
2. Have two EFSC Faculty members send your letters (or emails) of recommendation to the ASC Director, Dr. Kelly Dwenger, at dwengerk@easternflorida.edu . One recommendation must be from a faculty member teaching a course you would like to tutor.
3. Type your responses to the following questions. Do not exceed two pages in total.
 - i. What are the challenges new students face, academically and socially, in their transition to college and, specifically, Eastern Florida State College?
 - ii. Why do you want to be a Peer Tutor for EFSC?
 - iii. Please include a resume detailing your education, employment, campus activities and/or community service involvements. Indicate leadership positions where applicable.
