Course Description

This course will recertify and refresh the officer on the rules of breath alcohol analysis, using the Intoxilyzer 8000 Series. Student retraining will include the role of the breath test operator, the instrumentation used to analyze breath test samples according to Ch. 11D-8 Florida Administrative Code, how to obtain a proper breath test sample, the proper way to administer a breath test using the Intoxilyzer 8000, and courtroom testimony regarding the breath test that was conducted.

Each student must also successfully demonstrate proficiency in administering a breath test and completing the associated paperwork, as well as pass a written examination.
