Transfer of Fire Science Credits Private Institutions offering Fire Science Courses are generally not accepted. Public Accredited Institutional fire science credits are generally accepted.	Transfer of Fire Science Credits EFSC Continuing Education coursework can be transferred to College credit by meeting the specific requirements listed below, completing a credit by examination, and paying a \$50.00 fee for the exam.

Requirements to transfer Continuing Education Fire Science classes to College Credit

1. Current EFSC application on file with all requirements met
2. All admissions requirements are complete (transcripts on file, placement testing completed, etc.) including developmental education holds
3. Must be enrolled in EFSC in the AS/FRAS degree
4. Has paid all fees and has no outstanding financial obligations to the college
5. Must have completed 15 EFSC college credits for the AS/Fire Science program
6. Must be actively pursuing an AS/FRAS degree and currently enrolled in a CC class
7. Student must complete the credit by examination procedure (see the Fire Science Office for details)
