

# International Student Checklist Associate Degree



- Submit the online application by visiting EFSC's website www.easternflorida.edu
- Click APPLY
- Pay the \$30 application fee
- Submit the remaining documents to the International Student Services Office

## High School Graduation Documents

- Transcripts, Graduation Certificate/Diploma, Exam Results (if applicable)
- Must be equivalent to U.S. High School Diploma
- English translations required
- See the sample Country Requirements list on the website

## University Transcripts

- Official transcripts from all U.S. colleges attended
- International university transcripts are not required for admission. If you want to receive credit for international coursework, submit a Course-By-Course evaluation from a NACES member.



- TOEFL 61+ (EFSC code 5073)
- IELTS 5.5+
- STEP Grade 2A (Japan)
- Graduate from a U.S. High School
- Transfer from a U.S. college with a grade of "C" or higher in English Composition
- Complete Level 6 in EFSC's Intensive English Program

### Immigration Documents

- Copy of passport
- I-20 Request Form
- Official bank statement dated within 30 days with a minimum balance of \$22,426 USD

## Transfer Student Documents

- Visa transfer documents are only required from students currently attending a U.S. High School, College or University on an F-1 visa
- Copy of current I-20
- F-1 Transfer Clearance Form
- Copy of visa or I-797
- I-94
