

## Articulation Agreement - Postsecondary Vocational (PSAV) to AS Degree Early Childhood Education PSAV to AS Early Childhood Education Associate Degree **Memorandum of Understanding**

In accordance with the FDOE Postsecondary Adult Vocational (PSAV) to AS Degree Articulation below, Eastern Florida State College will award credit as follows:

Student must be enrolled in one of the following Programs: AS/CCAS - Early Childhood Education (1413121004) CCC/CHDI - Child Development Early Intervention (0419070904)

Credit will be awarded as follows:

## **Procedure for Obtaining Credit**

Student must meet the following criteria:

- Meet all EFSC admissions requirements pertaining to entering the program listed above.
- Be an active student currently enrolled in the program listed above and in good academic standing. Student's major must reflect the program listed in the agreement.
- Complete three credit hours of a technical course in the above listed program through traditional instruction at EFSC with a grade of "C" or better.
- Certification must NOT BE EXPIRED at the time the credit will be awarded, and the certification must have been issued within three years prior to enrollment in the program.
- Submit the "Petition for Articulated Credit" form and include a copy of the above listed certification to: EFSC, Office of the Registrar, 1519 Clearlake Road, Cocoa, FL 32922.
- Credit will be awarded with grade of "S" which will not affect the student's grade point average. Duplicate credit will not be awarded. Degrees or certificates are not conferred unless a minimum of 25% of the degree or certificate program requirements are completed through traditional coursework taken at EFSC.
- Questions regarding this agreement should be addressed to the Director of Career & Technical Programs or the Office of the Registrar.

Admission Requirements: Students entering the Associate in Applied Science and or the Associate in Science Program in <u>Early Childhood Education</u> must have a standard high school diploma or its equivalent, or a CPT Eligible Certificate of Completion. Students must meet the requirements of State Board Rule 6A-10.0315(3), FAC (College preparatory testing, placement, and instruction).

Validation Mechanisms: Current CDAE (Child Development Associate Equivalency) or ECPC (Early Childhood Professional Certificate) from program approved by the State Board of Education with transcript.

School district technical center and community college faculty committee met and agreed to propose that the <u>600</u> clock hour program in <u>Early Childhood Education</u> shall articulate <u>nine (9)</u> college credit hours in program core and/or program electives as locally determined by the Community College to the AAS/AS degree in <u>Early Childhood Education</u>. This agreement does not preclude but encourages the awarding of additional credits by any college through local agreements.

Community College: AAS/AS in Early Childhood Education

Will award course credits or a block of credit toward the AAS/AS program for 9 (nine) hours of credit.
