Memorandum of Understanding

Fire Fighter – College Credit for State Certification

Eastern Florida State College (EFSC) will award postsecondary credit to eligible students who have met the criteria as stated below. *The student will not be charged tuition or fees for the postsecondary credit awarded.*
EFFECTIVE TERM DATE: Spring 2014

EFSC will award the following credit for a State of Florida Certified Fire Fighter who is pursuing the AS Degree in Fire Science:

CRITERIA TO RECEIVE CREDIT

- Hold a Certificate of Compliance issued by the Division of State Fire Marshal, Bureau of Fire Standards and Training.
- Student must be currently enrolled in the AS Degree in Fire Science Technology (FRAS) at Eastern Florida State College:
- Submit copy of the Certificate of Compliance to: EFSC, Office of the Registrar
- In order to receive an EFSC degree student must complete a minimum of 25% of the degree/program requirements through traditional coursework taken at EFSC.
- Submit "Petition for Articulated Credit" form to the Program Coordinator/Manager or to the Dean of the Public Safety Institute


Credit will be awarded with grade of "S" which will not affect the student's grade point average. Duplicate credit will not be awarded.
