Eastern Florida State College (EFSC) will award postsecondary credit to eligible students who have met the criteria as stated below. The student will not be charged tuition or fees for the postsecondary credit awarded.

Student must be enrolled in the following Program: **PSAV/FRI2 – Fire Fighter (0743020303)**

Credit will be awarded as follows:

Procedure for Obtaining Credit

Student must meet the following criteria:


- Meet all EFSC admissions requirements pertaining to entering the program(s) listed above.
- Be an active student currently enrolled in the program listed above and in good academic standing. Student's major must reflect the program listed in the agreement.
- Hold a Certificate of Competency or Certificate of Completion for Fire Fighter 1 or Volunteer Fire Fighter from the Division of State Fire Marshall, Bureau of Fire Standings & Training. EFSC will also recognize 206 clock hour equivalent certifications issued by the Division of State Fire Marshall, Bureau of Fire Standings and Training, and verified by the Program Manager. The Certification must NOT BE EXPIRED at the time the credit will be awarded, and must have been issued within three years prior to enrollment in the program.
- Complete Fire Fighter 2 (FFP 0020) with EFSC prior to being awarded credit and submit Intent to Graduate Application and fee.
- Submit the "Petition for Articulated Credit" form and include a copy of the above listed certification to: **EFSC, Office of the Registrar, 1519 Clearlake Road, Cocoa, FL 32922.**
- Credit will be awarded with grade of "S" which will not affect the student's grade point average. Duplicate credit will not be awarded. Degrees or certificates are not conferred unless a minimum of 25% of the degree or certificate program requirements are completed through traditional coursework taken at EFSC.
- Questions regarding this agreement should be addressed to the Program Manager, the Public Safety Institute Dean, or the Office of the Registrar.


APPROVALS
