



Articulation Agreement – Prior Training and Licensure Memorandum of Understanding

Eastern Florida State College (EFSC) will award the following credit as stated below to eligible students who have the designated licensure. The student will not be charged tuition or fees for the credit awarded through this agreement. **EFFECTIVE TERM: Spring 2017**

Licensure: Florida Real Estate License for Sales Associates or Broker-Sales Associate in current status and good standing (As issued per the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation)

Applicable Degrees: AS Business Administration (CIP: 1552020102)

The procedure for obtaining the credit will be in accordance with the guidelines below.


Student must meet the following criteria:


1. All EFSC admissions requirements for a college credit program.
2. Be an active student, currently enrolled and declared in the major of the program listed above.
3. Hold a current Florida Real Estate License for Sales Associates or Broker-Sales Associate. License must NOT BE EXPIRED at the time the credit will be awarded and must have been issued no later than **five** years prior to enrollment in the program.
4. Pass a minimum of six college credit hours at EFSC that are part of the AS degree program requirements with grade of "C" or better.
5. Submit the Petition for Articulated Credit form, along with a copy of the current Florida Real Estate Sales Associate/Florida Broker-Sales Associate license to: EFSC, Office of the Registrar, 1519 Clearlake Road, Cocoa, FL 32922.
6. Credit will appear on student's permanent record and will be awarded as a grade of "S" and shall not exceed four credits. Duplicate credit will not be awarded.
7. Completion of a minimum of 25% of the degree/program requirements must occur through traditional coursework taken at EFSC in order for a degree to be awarded.


