

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
COMPETENCY-BASED CREDIT CROSSWALK

**ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY AAS

Brevard Community College (BCC) will award competency-based college credit toward the Applied Technology Specialist College Credit Certificate (CCC) and Engineering Technology Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree for eligible students who have taken the Harris Corporation Training courses listed below.



The procedure for obtaining the credit will be in accordance with the guidelines below.

1. Must meet all BCC admissions requirements including placement testing, and have all transcripts on file.
2. Be an active student currently enrolled in the AAS or CCC program, and be in good academic standing with a minimum 2.0 GPA.
3. Have completed a minimum of 25% of the applicable program requirements
4. Provide appropriate Harris Corporation Training Records for ALL courses listed; for OJT, a letter from Harris Corp Human Resources office must be submitted verifying that 18 hours of OJT in soldering has been met. Courses completed at any Harris facilities may be applied if the training is recorded in the HARRIS TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION RECORD SYSTEM.
5. Students desiring course credits from BCC through this MOU must request their Human Resource/Training Office forward a copy of their Training Record containing Course number and title, and/or OJT verification for evaluation to:

Questions regarding this agreement should be addressed to the Engineering Technology Curriculum Coordinator, the Workforce Program Director, and/or the Registrar.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective upon the signature of the community college president or his designee. This agreement shall remain in effect until reviewed and modified every two years, or terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice prior to the end of a term or by mutual consent.
