

Articulation Agreement – Statewide ATD to AS/AAS Degrees

Memorandum of Understanding

Per the Florida Department of Education Statewide Articulation Agreement, ATD to AS Degree Program, Eastern Florida State College (EFSC) will award postsecondary credit as stated below to eligible students. *The student will not be charged tuition or fees for the postsecondary credit awarded through this agreement.* EFFECTIVE TERM: Spring 2014

EFSC will award the following *college credit for students who are pursuing:

AS Degree Program Title: Medical Laboratory Technology

AS CIP: 1317030900 or 1351100405

Upon completion of MLT 2930 Pathology Seminar, MLTL 2527 Advanced Immunohematology Lab and MLT 1330 Hemostasis, all with grade of “C” or higher at EFSC, and completion of all required general education and support courses for the program, *all major course requirements in the Medical Laboratory Technology AS degree will be awarded not to exceed 40 credit hours. Credit will be awarded with grade of “S” and will not affect student’s grade point average. Duplicate credit will not be awarded.

Criteria to receive credit:


Student must meet the following criteria:

- All EFSC admissions requirements. Students entering the above program(s) must have a standard high school diploma or its equivalent, or a CPT Eligible Certificate of Completion, and must meet the requirements of State Board Rule 6A-10.0315(3) Common Placement Testing and Instruction.
- Student must be accepted into the Medical Laboratory Technology AS degree program and registered in program courses.
- Submit final, official transcripts to include proof of completion of a 1,515 clock hour Medical Clinical Laboratory Technician ATD program at a Florida Department of Education approved Tech Center and/or Community College to: EFSC, Office of the Registrar, 1519 Clearlake Road, Cocoa, FL 32922
- Complete a minimum of 25% of the Medical Laboratory Technology AS degree/program requirements through traditional coursework taken at EFSC prior to petitioning for credit.
- Student must be accepted by EFSC into the Medical Laboratory Technician program within four (4) years of completing the ATD articulated program.

Questions regarding this agreement should be addressed to the Medical Laboratory Technology Program Manager, the Office of the Vice President of Academic Affairs, and/or the Registrar.

APPROVALS

This Internal Articulation Agreement shall be effective upon the signatures below, and shall remain in effect until reviewed and modified every two years, or terminated by the Florida Department of Education. This agreement is subject to change by legislative action, the Department of Education, or the EFSC District Board of Trustees.
