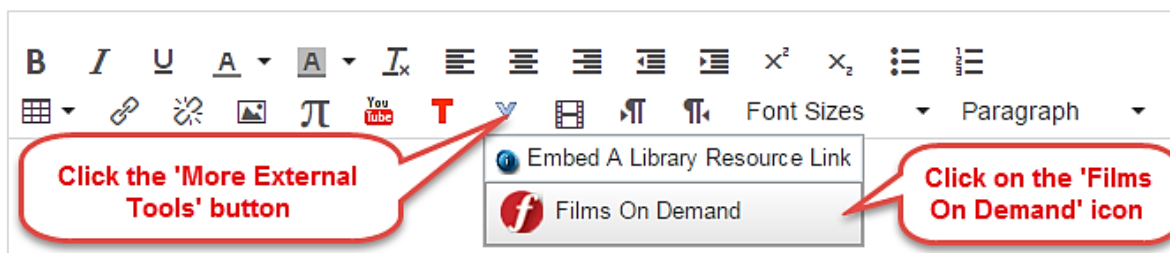


## Embedding Videos from Films On Demand (Library Database)

Films On Demand is a video database licensed by EFSC. The site offers a large collection of videos for every academic department. You can now easily search for videos and embed them into your Canvas content without having to log into the library database. Please follow the steps below to embed any of the FMG videos.

- Open an assignment, page, discussion, or quiz in editing mode (click the item and click on 'Edit').
- You will see the Rich Content Editor toolbar as shown below.
- Click the 'More External Tools' button and click on the 'Films on Demand' icon.



1. Enter a keyword to search for.
2. Click the search button. You will see a list of applicable videos below.
3. Scroll through the videos and click on 'Preview' if you would like to view a video before inserting it.
4. Click on the 'Embed' button to insert the video into the content area.

Save your content. Students will be able to view the video without having to log into the database.
