Memorandum of Understanding
Prior Training and Licensure
Registered Nurse to Bachelor of Science in Nursing

Effective Term: 202620

Upon acceptance into the Registered Nurse to Bachelor of Science in Nursing program, Eastern Florida State College (EFSC) will award up to the equivalent 42 college credits of core ADN courses to students transferring from an institution accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.

Additionally, EFSC will award equivalent credits of core ADN courses to former graduates of a Brevard Community College /EFSC AS/Nursing RN degree who meet all admissions requirements but may not have taken equivalent courses under the previous program.

Procedure for Obtaining Credit

Student must be enrolled in the following Program: **BSN/ Registered Nurse (RN) to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)**
CIPC: 1105138012

Student must meet the following criteria:

- Submit the EFSC online application and \$30 application fee
- Meet all EFSC admissions requirement for the degree, including the following:

Associate degree in nursing (ASN) from an institution accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.

- Active, clear Florida Registered Nursing license (hard copy not required; applicants must enter the license number and expiration date into EFSC' online admissions application)
- Submit all final, official regionally accredited college transcript(s) indicating the coursework taken and the degree(s) awarded
- Completion of the following courses with a grade of "C" or higher: BSCC 1010, BSCC 2093, BSCC 2094, ENC 1101, MAC 1105, MCBC 2010, Florida Civic Literacy and an eligible three-credit humanities course (submitted transcripts will be verified to ensure completion of required courses).
- Upon acceptance into the Registered Nurse (RN) to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN), the Office of the Registrar will evaluate the college transcripts and award applicable credit. Credit to be awarded for the core ADN courses shall not exceed 42 credits. Credit will appear on student's permanent record and will be awarded as a grade of "S". Completion of a minimum of 25% of the degree/program requirements must occur through traditional coursework taken at EFSC in order for a degree to be awarded. No duplicate credit will be awarded.
- Questions regarding this agreement should be addressed to the Dean of Nursing and Applied Health Sciences, RN-BSN Nursing Program Manager, or the Office of the Registrar.




